Our members continue their generous support of local charities. The most vulnerable in our community are even more so as the COVID pandemic persists.

NORTHVILLE CIVIC CONCERN: We are maintaining our support of this agency with non-perishable food donations. Most-requested items are oatmeal, non-sugar cereal, nutrition bars and canned fruit. Drop offs M - F, 9:00 - 1:00 at 43275 Seven Mile Rd. Call first: (248) 344-1033.

SONG AND SPIRIT: We are shifting our support to this interfaith agency which serves the homeless and those as risk of becoming homeless. Most-requested items are warm clothing, especially gently used men's coats and "Carepax." Warm clothes are needed through May and Carepax year-round.

CAREPAX: Carepax are gallon size Zip lock bags with essentials for people living on the streets. We can donate fully assembled Carepax or individual items to go into Carepax that will be assembled by Song and Spirit. Contents include warm clothes (gloves, hats, socks, hand and toe warmers), toiletries (soap, toothbrush and toothpaste, small size shampoo, conditioner, lotion, Chapstick), hand sanitizer, COVID mask, Dollar store rain poncho.

WARM CLOTHES: Our talented knitters are encouraged to make more hats. Gently used sweaters and coats, especially men's coats are high-demand items. Song and Spirit has given us instructions for making fleece hats and blankets. Anyone interested can contact Anne Marie Brady at (248) 478-1586.
